

Egypt Preparing Answer

CAIRO, Egypt, May 23 (UP)—
The Egyptian Government said to-
night it was preparing an answer
to the United Nations request for
a cease-fire agreement in Pales-
tine, but gave no details.

Informed sources said all Arab
states were in contact with each
other on the United Nations order.
These sources said Egypt would
accept an agreement only if it was
based on previously announced
terms: An end to Jewish immigra-
tion and disarmament of Jewish
military organizations.

The Communications Ministry
said the Cabinet had met to dis-
cuss the United Nations request
and was writing a reply, but re-
fused to comment further. [The
Associated Press quoted Egyptian
Foreign Minister Ahmad Mohamed
Khachaba Pasha as saying his
Government "will do our best to
